Tax Filing Deadline Dates

We expect a real busy tax season. If you want your work to be filed before 4/15, you need to get your materials out to us by March 20. Remember, if you are a corporation or business you may need to **issue 1099s or W2s by January 31** as well as **file any quarterly payroll work.** You also need to get your **partnership/corporate returns completed by March 15.** Personal returns are due April 15. My Son gets married April 18 so I will be distracted long before 4/15.

Changes for 2008 Taxes!

Non Itemizers Get Additional tax deduction. If you pay tax on your home but don't itemize on Schedule A, your standard deduction is increased.

Owners of Plug in Electrical Cars get a special tax credit.

1st Time Homebuyers get a special tax credit

Filing your taxes Late will now generate much increased late penalties.

Sales Tax is still deductible this year. Save your receipts for me if you buy a car, boat, or RV.

Federal Disaster Losses no longer need to exceed 10% of income to be deductible

Military Personnel will not be charged a penalty if they cash in their IRAs while serving.

Auto Mileage rate 50.5 cents for 1st half of year and 58.5 cents for second half
